INNOVATORS AWARD This award is for faculty members to explore innovative concepts in science that might use different paradigms to identify new opportunities for significant discoveries or new therapies, with the hope of a remarkable improvement in human health. Examples could include fundamental research, clinical research, diagnostic tests, biomarkers, biomedical engineering advances, and imaging advances. This award is for \$100,000 over two years (\$50,000 per year).

CAREER DEVELOPMENT AWARD This award is designed to support investigators early in their careers to obtain preliminary data in a key concept area that has high potential to lead to extended funding from NIH, EU, and other large research funding sources. This award is for \$100,000 over two years (\$50,000 per year).

VICTOR A. MCKUSICK FELLOWSHIP This award is designed to support postdoctoral fellows embarking on a scientific career in biomedical research related to any of the genetic aortic and vascular conditions that are within the Foundation's scope of interest. This award is for \$150,000 for an MD or \$100,000 for a PhD over two years (\$75,000 or \$50,000 per year).
